Teams play each opponent home and away over the calendar year

Also options for 2 "Jamborees" per year with games against teams from the New England Division (played in Albany over Columbus and Father's Day Weekends)



Teams will no longer enter EDP Leagues Cup due to NEAL commitment

Teams will still enter a Pre-Fall Tournament, a Spring Kick Off and a Memorial Day Tournament

All league games will be day trips (no overnight stays) but away games include trips to NJ, Westchester, Hudson Valley and CT

Other teams in age groups (e.g. B13 Bashers, B14 Destroyers) will continue in either EDP or LIJSL with options for EDP Leagues Cup or LI Cup and local tournaments.
